




Why CISOs Fail? /1

Why CISOs Fail? /2



When viewed as a technology (and not a business) problem, security tends to primarily serve as a business stopper. The CISO leads the Department of No (instead of the Department of How).

Share of security executives that believe that the board of directors sees security as a necessary cost rather than a way to gain competitive advantage


